REGISTRATION:

- Foyer of the Hunter Theatre. Entry to the school will be via GATE 5 on Cameron St, Broadmeadow. <u>DRESS CODE</u>
- Clothing appropriate casual.
- Clothing FINAL DAY good casual for the concert & presentation.
- MARCHING BAND MUST have a long sleeve shirt and wide brimmed hat.

EQUIPMENT

- Instrument and music.

SUPERVISION

- HSPA staff.
- Music tutors to conduct sectional rehearsals.

AIM:
