- Canteen Report see report attached.
 - A second air con unit for the canteen was discussed in March AGM and followed up in this meeting. Quotes received by exec committee has support for second unit purchase.
- POPPAS Report
 - Mother's Day stall approaching
 - $^\circ$ $\,$ Dee is arranging lunch packs for the primary drama camp

- Music Subcommittee Report
 - Very excited to be based in the new Band Centre
 - Lots of working bees happening to have everything in place
 - BBQ and cake stall at National Band Championships raised \$2,500
 - Music Faculty report noted many recent engagements for music students (see HSPA social media)
 - Harriet asked Dave to raise a couple of points
 - Music committee want to purchase a second square tile base station for new band centre.
 - Darren advises that they need to also purchase an iPad or other device to support its use
 - Music committee want to investigate the use of PayID as a form to accept payments with NSW P+C Org. E.G: for Band Uniforms etc
 - Approval for up to \$500 for: new ladder, ironing board and material to make a change room curtain in new band centre
 - Principal & Committee Approved
 - Approval for total \$1000 to purchase a bolt of colour guard material to make additional Colour Guard Uniforms.
 - Principal & Committee Approved
- Principal's report Darren Ponman
 - No specific report this week given his weekly updates going to the whole school via emailed newsletter links.
 - The Band Centre is a joint funded initiative HSPA saved and contributed \$200,000 and that contribution was matched by the Department. However, when renovations commenced, half of the existing centre fell to bits, which eventually meant that the Department contributed over \$1million (but the project took way longer than anticipated). The school put further funds towards some important variations, as noted in March minutes.
 - Darren will aim to report to the next P&C meeting on other funding priorities from the faculties for the P&C can consider future opportunities.
 - The P&C is tasked to consider how much funding to contribute to offset the school's considerable additional costs, as those school funds were taken from other initiatives.
 - Darren notes that the digital sign is still sitting with Council so we can't know yet when that cost might arise.
 - P&C determined recently that it should have \$30,000 in reserve to cover costs that may arise for the canteen. Dee and Darren note that the air conditioner soon to be installed in the canteen may cost around \$10,000.

MOTION: That the P&C contribute \$70,000 towards the school's costs for the Band Centre. Moved: Barry Dismoor Seconded: Michelle Offen Motion approved with no objections.

- Amanda raises the planned mobile phone ban to check on the school's planned approach.
 - Darren reports that he is currently surveying staff on their thoughts
 - The school will also consult with families
 - Department has indicated that it will be flexible in terms of school implementation but Darren notes that the school's will need to be a bit more rigid than the current approach if it is to be effective in preventing phone use during break time
 - Darren is keen to ensure that any approach doesn't introduce a block on teacherstudent relations
 - Kevin asks to what extent are students engaged in conversation around this? Darren responds that the student leadership team will be engaged early and tasked with trying to build a sense of student sentiment. Once a draft policy is developed, that would be an optimal time to consult with students.
