Food	<p>The camp will be catered for the following meals: Day 1 - morning tea, lunch, afternoon tea, dinner, supper Day 2 - breakfast, morning tea, final lunch</p> <p>There will be meals provided for allergies/intolerances/dietary requirements if staff are appropriately notified. Parents/caregivers must notify staff of dietary or medical requirements prior to students attending the camp.</p> <p>Students are also encouraged to bring snacks. Foods with nuts are not permitted.</p>
