Newcastle City PSSA Rules & Regulations.

1. Schools may enter up to three competitors per event. Please note that 8/9 years is ONE EVENT and 12/13 years is ONE EVENT.

PARENTS MUST COMPLETE THE ONLINE ENTRY FORM FOR EACH COMPETITOR AS DIRECTED TO ON THE LETTER TO STUDENTS

Each student will require a copy of the letter at the bottom of this document.

2. Entry fee will be **\$5** per competitor. Please pay your money to the front office. This will not be collected on the day. Schools will be invoiced later.

3. All competitors must wear shoes (no spikes). Failure to wear shoes will lead to disqualification.

4. No competitors may receive assistance or refreshments during the race, except in the case of asthma puffers.

- 5. No pushing or tripping on purpose is allowed.
- 6. Spectators are to keep OFF the track.

7. Competitors are to wear a name tag showing name, age division and school. These need to be organised by the accompanying teacher and distributed before the races commence.

8. Protests are to be made to the Convenor within 10 mins of completion of an event by the accompanying teacher.

A canteen will be available on the day however bring something to eat from home.

If you are unable to make the championship, please inform your school sports coordinator as soon as possible.
