We are very excited to be involved in Star Struck once more after the unfortunate cancellation last year due to COVID. In order to get the show up and running this year it has been made into two separate shows 90 minute shows involving two casts with no interval. This will see the Primary students split into “Cast A” and “Cast B”. Due to the calibre of our students at HSPA, we will be split across the two casts.

As a part of their commitment to the show students have completed their two item rehearsal days and now have combined movement rehearsal days and performance week coming up before the end of term.

CAST A - Year 6 Dance and Drama students will perform the Friday Matinee and Saturday Evening shows.

CAST B – Year 5 Dance and Drama students will perform the Friday Evening and Saturday Matinee shows.

There are also a number of students who are attending Star Struck only in the Featured Dance Ensemble and are NOT a part of the school casts. If this is the case, they will be supervised by a teacher provided by Star Struck and will not be the responsibility of HSPA Staff. They will receive direct correspondence from Star Struck regarding their requirements.

REHEARSALS & PERFORMANCE DETAILS

All combined rehearsals and performances will occur at the Newcastle Entertainment Centre (NEC) Broadmeadow. Please enter via the white gates on Brown Road and meet teachers on the grassed area between the NEC and the centre ring. Supervising teachers will meet and dismiss students from this designated area only. Please look for the school sign.

Please make sure to have your child’s name marked off with their coordinating teacher before taking them home. If another parent is taking your child home, please send in a note to the coordinating teacher.

NO DEVICES OF ANY KIND ARE PERMITTED DURING SHOW WEEK. THESE WILL BE CONFISCATED BY SUPERVISING TEACHERS AND RETURNED AT THE END OF THE DAY.

PARKING

Parents and patrons coming to watch the performances are encouraged to park in the Newcastle Showground. A \$10 fee will apply. Entrance to the carpark is via Griffiths Road.

NO parking is available in Brown Road for any vehicle before, during or after performances. Alternate parking for drop-offs and pick-ups can be found at PCYC or District Park.

Parking is difficult due to the traffic at peak times. Please allow plenty of time to arrive prior to drop off times and to park before pick up times.

COSTUME TUBS

Each performer will require a clear 52 litre plastic tub to store their costumes and belongings in during show week. All performers will be given a name label to attach to their tubs.

On Monday 7th June, dramatists will need to bring in their tub and all parts of their costumes to be checked.

On Friday 11th June, dancers will need to bring in their tub with their white canvas shoes inside. They will be given their costumes to bring home on this day.
